

2010-2011 DPTA Circuit Guidelines

Tournaments open to non-qualified players
(Champ-Super Champ are Not Eligible)

Players that live in "75" zip code will earn points to qualify for season-ending Masters tournament. players living outside of this zip code may play, but will not be eligible for the Masters tournament.

Juniors must play their age division as of

OCT 1, 2012

If you qualify after August 1st, you will still be eligible for Masters (and potentially state tournament)

DPTA /USPTA pro committee has the final decision on any rules not covered

No refunds for rain or incorrect sign ups or cancellation for any reason

The DPTA Junior Circuit Masters (invitation only, based on the other tournament results throughout the year) winners qualify to represent Dallas in the USPTA-Texas Junior Circuit Championships!

Format: 8-game pro set (first to 8 games, and ahead by 2), ad (regular) scoring, tiebreak at 7 games-all

Players guaranteed at least two matches if opponents are available

Players receive 1 point for wins in main draw (must win the round after a bye or default)

Players receive .5 point for wins in consolation draw (must win the round after a bye or default)

If you default or pull out of a tournament, you will receive no points

Top 8 point-earning players will be invited to the Masters tournament (must have played in a minimum of 4 tournaments)

(if you default more than two times from a tournament, you will be ineligible for the Masters, which means you won't qualify for the state trip)

Tournament Director reserves the right to modify scoring in case of inclement weather.

Being current with USTA guidelines: if a rainout occurs, the tournament director will make every effort to reschedule the tournament before the next JC tournament. If every effort has been made and there is absolutely no way to complete the tournament, there will be no refunds

I have included detailed instructions on how to find our tournaments on tennis link. I have also included links to the individual tournaments to make it easy.

To Sign-up go to www.usta.com/tennislink. Click on the link for junior tournaments. On the tournament finder page enter the Tournament ID # (Above) for the tournament you are signing up. It will then give you a link to that tournament. Click that link and on the tournament page click the link to register online. (NOTE this page because this is where you will come back to check starting times and playing locations on the **Thursday** before the tournament)
